12. **High School Graduation.** Give the date (month, year) that you graduated from high school or the expected date of your high school graduation.
13. Give the name, address and phone of the college to which you have been accepted and plan to attend.
14. **Self-Reported Academic GPA (AGPA).** Your **AGPA** is based on the credit hours and grades earned in the **college preparatory** mathematics and science courses taken in grades 9-12. Compute your **AGPA** using the following example as your guide. **List all mathematics courses before science and please list one course per line.** Use additional sheets if needed.

EXAMPLE

Use the following scale to compute your **AGPA**:

(A- or A =4) (B-, B or B+ =3) (C-, C or C+ =2) (D-, D or D+ =1) (I, P, W, or E=0).

COURSE NAME	CREDIT HOURS	GRADE VALUE	Column X multiplied by Column Y
Algebra I	0.5	A=4	$0.5 \times 4 = 2.0$
Algebra II	0.5	C=2	$0.5 \times 2 = 1.0$
Chemistry I	0.5	B=3	$0.5 \times 3 = 1.5$
TOTAL	1.5		4.5

ACADEMIC GPA = 4.5 divided by 1.5 = 3.0. (**TOTAL** from Column Z divided by **TOTAL** from Column X rounded to the nearest tenth.) **Your AGPA is 3.0.**

15. **Personal Statement.** Describe yourself. Your personal statement should be approximately one page (typed, single spaced) and should include your educational and professional goals/objectives and your plans for attaining each. Be specific.
16. You must attach a copy of your 2025-2026 **FAFSA** Submission Summary including your Student Aid Index (**SAI**).
17. You must attach a copy of your most recent official **ACT® Plus Writing** Student Report or your **SAT** Score Report.
18. **Signature.** Please sign and date your application. Unsigned applications **will not** be processed.

In addition to the application, it is the applicant's responsibility to have an *official* high school transcript and two (2) letters of recommendation on file with the Selection Committee. Recommendations and transcripts must be mailed separately from the application. Your complete application must be postmarked no later than midnight April 15, 2026. Late, inaccurate or incomplete applications will not be processed. Mail to:
